Design-Build Institute of America (DBIA) Florida Region offers competitive scholarships to students pursuing a program related to architecture, engineering and construction at an accredited university/college in the State of Florida. The competitive scholarships are awarded by the DBIA Florida Region Board and are currently available in various amounts up to a maximum (lifetime/individual) of \$1500. All scholarships are awarded for use in the fall term of the next academic year.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Have completed one year of college, be currently enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited university/college for the fall term, and be pursuing a program in one of the following disciplines:
 - Building Construction/Construction Management
 - Architecture/Interior Design
 - Architecture/Civil/Construction Engineering
- Possess a GPA of 3.0 or higher (using a 4.0 grading scale)
- Complete and submit the online application
- Be enrolled full-time in a program for the fall term. Applicants in their final undergraduate year must have been accepted to attend a full-time graduate program in the next academic year to qualify for a scholarship.

Application Requirements

The Applicant is responsible to provide the following information to the DBIA Florida Scholarship Committee.

1. Completed/signed Application Form
2. Official transcript of grades for the three (3) most recent semesters
3. Listing of Extracurricular Activities
4. Employment History
5. Completed Essay

Application Process

The following represents key milestones in the DBIA Florida Region scholarship process:

February 1: The application period starts.

March 18-31: Completed applications are sent to the Board of Directors (BOD) scholarships@fldbia.org for review.

April 19: The BOD identifies finalists, selects recipients, and determines scholarship amounts.

April 26: All applicants are notified of the final results. Scholarship recipients provide information necessary for the disbursement of funds.

First Week of August: Scholarship funds are disbursed to the universities/colleges of the scholarship recipients.
